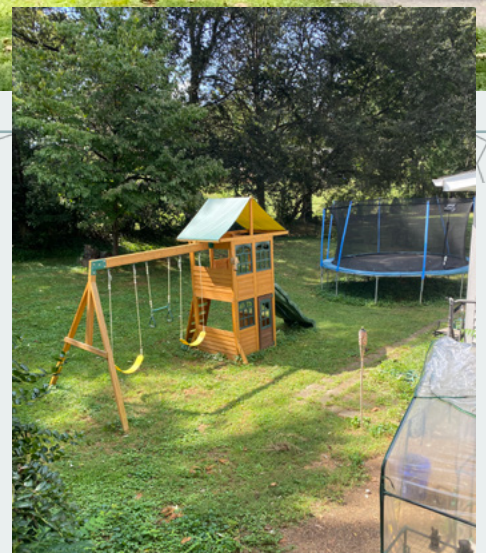

We also have a large fish tank with an assortment of fish.

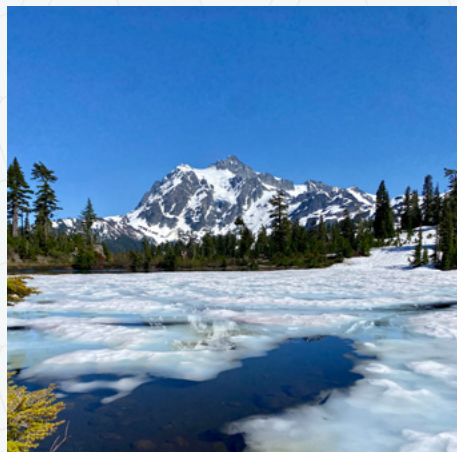




Things we love
