We are so excited to become parents and know this child will be incredibly loved and taken care of throughout their life. Thank you for possibly considering us as future parents, we are incredibly grateful.








I grew up in NYC and didn't officially move to the south until I was in my late 20s. I'm the youngest of five in my family.

WHAT DANIEL LOVES MOST ABOUT ALEXANDRA






WHAT ALEXANDRA LOVES MOST ABOUT DANIEL

WE LOVE OUR DOGGS (LIKE, A LOT.)


We have 2 amazing dogs. Bo is our 12 year old great dane. He is our gentle giant! He loves to be pet and thinks he is a lap dog.


I curently have three siblings and two nieces.

our FAITH


