OUR STORY


We first met on the Sunday after Thanksgiving at church. We talked about many things, and ever since then we have been in one continuous conversation. We got married 3 years later in the same church.

We love to read (sometimes aloud to each other), hike, take our dog on walks, cook, and watch movies together.









A LITTLE ABOUT MARIANNE






OUR DOG








OUR HOUSE

SHADY'S FAMILY




